This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby ~~grant~~ the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

Applications 41626, 41633, 41634, 55865, 55866, 55867 and 55868 are hereby DENIED on the grounds that to approve said applications would threaten to prove detrimental to the public interest and that the assignee of the applications acquired the applications for the purpose of speculation. No ruling is made as to the merits of the protest of the U.S.D.I., Bureau of Land Management.
