hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.1 CFS second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal purposes

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within Lot 2 of Section 16, T.19N, R.19E., M.D.M. or at a point from which the northeast corner of said Section 16 bears N. 32° 12' E. 2841 Feet.

6. Place of use within Lot 2 of Section 16, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.M. on parcels A through F of Record of Survey Number 703, Official Records of Washoe County.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31 of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well, submersible pump and piping to existing houses.

9. Estimated cost of works \$20,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works 1 year  
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 3 years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

This application is made to replace an existing well which has provided water to five dwellings for approximately the last 40 years without benefit of a permit from the State Engineer.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.825 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 26, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 26, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 26, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 26, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

The State Engineer is approving this application only because the five families have been on a well with no permit for over forty years. There will be no increase in the draft on the underground resource. No new homes are allowed to be built and served by this well, it is limited to the existing homes.
