hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 17364 (Certificate 6622)

- 1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.71 cfs (160 acre-feet annually)
3. The water to be used for irrigation & domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation & domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, T.14N., R.26E., MDM, at a point from which the NW Corner of said Section 14 bears N 37 0 47' 30" W, a distance of 1843.80 feet
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15, T.14N., R.26E., MDM, at a point from which the East 1/4 Corner of said Section 15 bears S 45 0 0' E, a distance of 1850.0 feet
7. Proposed place of use 20.00 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15 & 20.00 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, both in T.14N., R.26E., MDM - 40.00 acres total
8. Existing place of use 40.00 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15, T.14N., R.26E., MDM
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) a drilled & cased well equipped with a motor, pump & pipeline to irrigation ditches throughout the place of use
12. Estimated cost of works \$25,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works one year

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use four years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

Use map filed under Permit 17364 for the existing point of diversion & place of use. Use map filed under Permit 26530 for the proposed point of diversion. A temporary application (56476-T) has been filed on this point of diversion with permit 17364 as the base. Once this permanent application to changed is approved, the temporary permit which has been filed to save the existing crops, will no longer be needed.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 17364, Certificate 6622 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 17364, Certificate 6622 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 17364, Certificate 6622 and 56280 shall not exceed 552 acre-feet annually.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter from this well and the well under Permit 17364.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.71 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 17, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 17, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 17, 1994

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 17, 1994

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 17, 1994
