hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion

of water heretofore appropriated under 29873 Certificate 10129

Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 5.4 cfs 2,560.0 acre ft. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 S 32 T23N R54E Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and see attached scetch distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SW 1/4 S 32 T23N. R54E MDB&M or If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer. at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 32 bears S 45° 0' E a distance of 141.42 feet. (See PBU map under 29873

7. Proposed place of use 640 Acres Section 32 T23N R54E see pbu map under 29873 Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use Same as item 7 Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from 1 Jan to 31 Dec of each year. Month and Day

I would like to continue to use old point of diversion as my domestic well. Existing well has started to pump sand, and we need a new well to finish irrigation season.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29873, Certificate 10129 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29873, Certificate 10129 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 19145, Certificate 6719; 29873, Certificate 10129; 30102, Certificate 10113; 36070, Certificate 10135; 50650 and 56542-T shall not exceed 2560.0 acre-feet annually.

The total diversion of water under this permit and any and all permits issued on Section 32, T.23N., R.54E., MDM shall not exceed 14.3 cfs.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 2560 acre-feet annually.


