APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 49173 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 49173 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from each well and the amount of water used.

The well drilled under Permit 49173 must be plugged and abandoned within 30 days from the issuance of this permit in accordance with the Nevada Regulations for Water Well and Related Drilling.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.0 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 27, 1993

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 27, 1993

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 27, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 27, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
