1. The source of water is Underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.7791 c.f.s. or not to exceed 311.64 acre-feet per season

3. The water to be used for Irrigation

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 33, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.M., bears S. 43° 21' E., 14,811.00 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE Corner of Section 33, T., 12N., R.62E., M.D.M., bears S. 43° 21' E., 14,811.00 feet.

7. Proposed place of use. Portions of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20; SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and portions of NW 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, of Section 29; Portions of NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, all in T.12N., R.62E. M.D.B.&M.

8. Existing place of use. 13.52 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. 12.47 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. 6.54 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. 11.65 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, T.12N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M. 77.91 Acres Total Note: 4.00 acre-feet per acres per season is granted by this certificate.

9. Use will be from April 1 to November 30 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from April 1 to November 30 of each year.

The purpose of this application is to co-mingle permit 11312 with permits 14380 and 32317 for better water management, and to show the correct location of the point of diversion and place of use based on the M.L.M. 1972 Dependent Resurvey.

**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 11312 (Certificate 3151) is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 11312 (Certificate 3151) and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57058, 57059 and 57060 shall not exceed 1059.2 acre-feet per season.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.7791 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 311.64 acre-feet per season, and not to exceed a seasonal duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 14, 1998

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 14, 1998

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 14, 2001

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 14, 2001

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 14, 2001
