1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.02731 cfs 9.08 acre feet annually

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian at a point from which the northeast corner of said Section 5 bears North 66°17'59" East, 2969.86 feet. (Well No. 2)

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 32 Township 23 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, at a point from which the southwest corner of said Section 32 bears South 41° 59'42" West, 3915.67 feet. (Well No. 1)
If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Section 32, Township 23 North, Range 21 East and NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 21 East, all in Mount Diablo Meridian.

8. Existing place of use 2.27 acres within the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, and the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian. (Remainder of Parcel 101)

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30111, Certificate 10581 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30111, Certificate 10581 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57085, 57086, 57087, 57088, 57089 and 57095 shall not exceed 341.60 acre-feet annually.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57088 and 57089 shall not exceed 9.08 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.02731 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 9.08 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 18, 1995

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 18, 1995

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 18, 1998

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 18, 1998

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 18, 1998
