APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of an Unnamed Spring No. 1 as heretofore granted under Permit 25549, Certificate 11024 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 25549, Certificate 11024 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0265 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 19.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 20, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 20, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 20, 1998

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 20, 1998

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
