APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the manner of use of the waters of Reinken Spring No. 3 as heretofore granted under Permit 16011, Certificate 4614 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 16011, Certificate 4614 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57319 and 57320 shall not exceed 1.46 million gallons annually.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The place of use of Permits 57319 and 57320 is limited to one dwelling located on 20 acres, within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 29, T.18N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0062 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.46 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 18, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 18, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 18, 1998


