APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the place of use of waters of Lower Rawhide Spring as heretofore granted under Permit 45383 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 45383, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Issuance of this permit totally abrogates Permit 45383.

This permit is subject to existing rights, included, but not limited to RO6131.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.032 cubic feet per second, or sufficient water to water 1000 head of cattle and 25 head of horses.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 14, 1999

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 14, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 14, 2000

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 14, 2000

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
