APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 44874 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 44874 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued with the express understanding and on the condition that existing grazing use of the public range by authorized users or permittees will not be impaired or adversely affected by approval and issuance of this permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.005cubic feet per second....., or sufficient to water 160
.....head of cattle and 25 antelope.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... October 3, 1993

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... November 3, 1993

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... October 3, 1994
