hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 51753

1. The source of water is an Underground Source

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.193 CFS not to exceed 6.45 million gallons annually

3. The water to be used for No change

4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal Purposes

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 2 bears S 54 degrees E, 1,500 feet

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 1, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of Section 1 bears N 15 degrees W, 1,100 feet

7. Proposed place of use SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 2, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Douglas County, Nevada

8. Existing place of use N 1/2 SW 1/4, N 1/2 SE 1/4 in Section 1; NE 1/4, portion of E 1/2 NW 1/4, portion of E 1/2 SW 1/4, N 1/2 SE 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 in Section 2, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.; E 1/2 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 in Section 36, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., all in Douglas County, Nevada

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well, pump and motor, and pipelines to the place of use

12. Estimated cost of works \$200,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works 5 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 51753 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 51753 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57673, 57674 and 57675 shall not exceed 6.45 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.193 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 6.45 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 22, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 22, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 22, 1997

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 22, 1997
