hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 56290

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 12.29 AF (0.0409 CFS)
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 35, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the Northwest corner of said Section 35 bears N. 78° 41' 08" W., 1267 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13, T.12N., R.21E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the West one-quarter corner of said Section 13 bears N. 22° 46' W., a distance of 1,126 feet.
7. Proposed place of use portions of SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 26, SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 27, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 and the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 35, all within T.13N., R.20E., M.D.M., Douglas County, Nevada (3.99 acres to be irrigated).
8. Existing place of use 3.99 acres within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14, T.12N., R.21E., M.D.M., to be severed from irrigation.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well with submersible pump and motor and pipelines.
12. Estimated cost of works \$2,500
13. Estimated time required to construct works Two (2) years

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use. Two (2) years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

The purpose of this application to change is to modify the place of use and point of diversion of the subject rights to properties controlled by the Jarretts in conformance with the previously submitted deed. Permits 57726 and 57727 should be combined for a total of 15.96 AF and 3.99 acres.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56290 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56290 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57726 and 57727 shall not exceed 15.96 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 3.99 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0409 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 12.29 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 11, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 11, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 11, 1997

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 11, 1997

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 11, 1997
