APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim No. 208 1/2, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.187 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 32.10 acre-feet as decreed, and not to exceed a decreed duty of 4.5 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 30, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 30, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 30, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 30, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 30, 1996
