Point of Diversion, Manner & Place of Use of a Portion
of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 53818

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.032 c.f.s.
3. The water to be used for Recreation & Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 30, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 30 bears N. 07° 50' 00" W., a distance of 2200 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 19 bears S. 56° 08' 03" W., a distance of 2219.74 feet.
7. Proposed place of use Portions of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 30, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.& M.
8. Existing place of use E 1/2 SW 1/4 and portions of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.& M. 100 acres. Acreage to be removed is 32.25 acres.
9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) a drilled well, pump, motor and distribution system
12. Estimated cost of works \$30,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

The total combined water under Permits 37953 to be changed shall not exceed 129 AFA. The proposed use is for a water ski lake.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 53818 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 53818 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57804 and 57805 shall not exceed 129 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.032 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 7.4 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 20, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 20, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 20, 1995

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 20, 1995

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 20, 1995

Completion of work filed MAY 20 1994

Proof of beneficial use filed JUN 21 1995

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57539, 57540, 57804 and 57805 shall not exceed 161 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet below ground level or below the first confining layer which ever is greater.

This permit is issued subject to the agreement between William Joseph Richter and Frontier Enterprise, Inc.

This permit is limited to use in the water ski pond and for no other use. The amount of water put to beneficial use shall be the water required to offset the evaporation loss from the pond for recreation purposes. A meter reading must be submitted to the State Engineer at the completion of the filling of the pond.
