APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 37953 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 37953 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57804 and 57805 shall not exceed 129 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.613 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 121.6 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 20, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 20, 1995

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The total combined duty of water under Permits 57539, 57540, 57804 and 57805 shall not exceed 161 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet below ground level or below the first confining layer which ever is greater.

This permit is issued subject to the agreement between William Joseph Richter and Frontier Enterprise, Inc.

This permit is limited to use in the water ski pond and for no other use. The amount of water put to beneficial use shall be the water required to offset the evaporation loss from the pond for recreation purposes. A meter reading must be submitted to the State Engineer at the completion of the filling of the pond.
