The applicant **City of Reno, City of Sparks, Washoe County and Lands of Sierra, Inc.**, by and through **Westpac Utilities**, a division of **Sierra Pacific Power Co.**, hereby make application for permission to change the **Point of Diversion, Manner of Use and Place of Use** of water heretofore appropriated under a portion of Claim Nos. 52½, 78, 81 and 82 and all of Claim No. 62 of the Truckee River Decree, said Decree entered by the District Court of the United States for Nevada in that certain action entitled **The United States of America, Plaintiff, vs. Orr Water Ditch Company, et al, Defendants**", in Equity Docket No. A-3.

1. The source of water is **Truckee River**
2. The amount of water to be changed **1.981 cfs not to exceed 463.31 acre feet annually**
3. The water to be used for **Municipal and Domestic**
4. The water heretofore permitted for **As Decreed**
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point **the points of diversion of Sierra's existing water treatment plants as described in attached Exhibit "A" and shown on the map supporting Application Nos. 49886 and 49887, on file with the Division of Water Resources, State of Nevada.**
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within **the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE¼SW¼) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., from said point the Southwest corner of Section 32, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., bears S 62°04' E, a distance of 3195.00 feet (Steamboat Canal).**
7. Proposed place of use **The certificated water service area of Sierra Pacific Power Company as described in the legal description and shown on the supporting map on file with the State Engineer's Office, Division of Water Resources.**
8. Existing place of use **Please see attached "Orr Ditch Decree Claim Transfer Table".**
9. Use will be from **As Decreed.**
10. Use was permitted from **As Decreed.**
11. Description of proposed works **Water will be diverted by existing company facilities, treated and placed into the existing distribution system.**
12. Estimated cost of works **Sierra has invested in excess of \$50 million in its water treatment and distribution system.**
13. Estimated time required to construct works **Completed**
14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **One year**

15. Remarks: During 1991, Sierra served an average of 54,945 non-duplicate customers and delivered approximately 59,200 acre feet of water. Maximum day delivery was 101.55 million gallons (311.6 acre feet). This application is transferring 150.90 acre feet for City of Reno, 10.70 acre feet for City of Sparks, 203.76 acre feet for Washoe County and 97.95 acre feet for Lands of Sierra, Inc., pursuant to the Water Treatment and Distribution Agreements/Water Sale Agreement per the chains of title.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claims 52½, 62, 78, 81/82, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.766 cubic feet per second, **but not to exceed 456.31 acre-feet as decreed.**



The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Sierra Pacific Power Company Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the maps accompanying Application Nos. 49886 and 49887 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.
