The applicant Sam S. Jaksick, Jr. and the Estate of Thelma M. Jaksick, deceased 2500 Spinnaker Drive of Reno Nevada 89509 hereby make application for permission to change the

Point of Diversion, Manner and Place of Use of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 12807, Certificate No. 3699

1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.068 cfs, not to exceed 22.4 acre feet

3. The water to be used for irrigation of golf course, recreation & domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for as Decreed Irr & Dom

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, T19N, R19E, M.D.M., or a point from which the Northeast Corner of said Section 35 bears N 73°18' 28"E, a distance of 2,185 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 36, T19N, R19E, M.D.M., or a point from which the Southeast Corner of said Section 36 bears S 11° 27'E, a distance of 1,425.60 feet.

7. Proposed place of use Portions of NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, and SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 26, T19N, R19E, M.D.M., and NW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 35, T19N, R19E, M.D.M., containing approximately 160 acres.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 12807, Certificate 3699 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 12807, Certificate 3699 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on November 13, 1992 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.068 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 22.4 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....
