hereby make application for permission to change the Point of diversion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #47267

Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is underground.

2. The amount of water to be changed 2.228 cfs, not to exceed 1,612.57 acre-feet annually.

3. The water to be used for Fish Hatchery operation.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Fish Hatchery operation.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 23, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 23 bears N. 85° 46' 23" E. a distance of 652.53'.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 14, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 14 bears S. 12° 46' E. a distance of 2,791 feet.

7. Proposed place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 23, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

8. Existing place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 23, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.)

Well, pump, and distribution piping to Lahontan National Fish Hatchery and discharged to Allerman Canal.

12. Estimated cost of works \$200,000.00

13. Estimated time required to construct works 2 years.

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 2 years.

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

Water will be pumped to the Fish Hatchery and then discharged to Allerman Canal. The water is then withdrawn by other users.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 47267 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 47267 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The issuance of this permit expires Permit 57987-T.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.228 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1612.57 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 18, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 18, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 18, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 18, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
