NEVADA 89041, hereby make... application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.22 cfs second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for commercial Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point located within the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 2, T21S, R53E, M.D.B.&M. Nye County, Nev.; or at a point from which survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. the Southwest Corner of said Section 2 bears South 75° 03' 10" W 1326.45 feet, more or less.

6. Place of use E 1/2 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2 T21S, R53E, M.D.B.&M. Nye Co. Nevada Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January - 1st and end about December 31-st, of each year. Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, casing, pump and piping to shop and office buildings. State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches and flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:
 This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.
 This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 3.50 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 22, 1995
 Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 22, 1995
 Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 22, 1997
 Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 22, 1997
 Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
