Water is to be commingled with water from other Rabbit Creek Mining, Inc. permits (52046 through 52051 and 53339 through 53341) for a total combined duty of 3,630 AFA. Water is to be used in a milling and heap leach mining complex.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52049 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52049 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 52046, 52047, 52048, 52049, 52050, 52051, 53339, 53340, 53341, 57724-T, 57725-T, 58014-T and 58015-T shall not exceed 3620 acre-feet annually.

## (PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

This temporary permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This temporary permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the State Engineer's Ruling No. 3606 dated May 19, 1989.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on January 18, 1994 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.
