APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 51887 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 51887 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 51884, 51886, 58020, 58021 and 58022 shall not exceed 250 million gallons annually.

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.45 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 106 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 22, 1993

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 22, 1993

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 22, 1994

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 22, 1994

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
