

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Board of County Commissioners, County of Elko, State of Nevada, as trustee for the Tuscarora Water District

Courthouse, Room 106, of Elko, Nevada 89801

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Town Well #1

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.25 c.f.s. second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for municipal

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, T.40N., R.51E., MDM, from which the SW corner of said section bears S. 11° 38' W., 4,546 ft. dist.

6. Place of use T.39N., R.51E., Section 3, Lots 1 and 2 T.40N., R.51E., Section 33, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 T.40N., R.51E., Section 34, W 1/2 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, W 1/2 SE 1/4, SE 1/4 SE 1/4

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled and cased well, submersible pump, water treatment station, pipelines, storage tank

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 5.825 million gallons annually.

- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 21, 1995
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 21, 1995
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 21, 1999
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 21, 1999
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
