hereby make application for permission to change the
point of diversion of a portion and the place of use
of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 43405, Certificate 10699

- 1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.60 second feet
3. The water to be used for irrigation
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T30N, R35E MDB&M, or at a point from which the SW 1/4 of said Section 16 bears S 47 degrees W, a distance of 67 feet.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 22, T30N, R35E, MDB&M, or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 22 bears N 5 degrees 59.5' W, a distance of 1,445.1 feet.
7. Proposed place of use NW 1/4 NW 1/4 - 40.0 acres, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 - 39.76 acres, SE 1/4 NW 1/4 - 39.53 acres, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 - 40.0 acres, NW 1/4 NE 1/4 - 39.76 acres, SW 1/4 NE 1/4 - 39.76 acres, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 31.57 AC all in Section 22, T30N, R35E, MDB&M. A total of 270.38.
8. Existing place of use 40 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4, 13.33 acres, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, 40.0 acres, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 & 31.57 acres, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, all in Section 22, T30N, R35E, MDB&M. A total of 124.9 acres.
9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) New drilled well.
12. Estimated cost of works \$30,000
13. Estimated time required to construct works 30 days

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... 60 days

Water under this will be comingled with other water rights held by the applicant to accomplish the most beneficial use for the property.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 43405, Certificate 10699 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 43405, Certificate 10699 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 29524, 43403, 43404, 43405, 43406, 47736, 58570, 58571, 58572 and 58573 shall not exceed 1081.52 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.60 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly

duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 9, 1995

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 9, 1995

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 9, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 9, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 9, 1996

Completion of work filed FEB 22 1995

Proof of beneficial use filed FEB 28 1996
