1. The source of water is the Truckee River Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.028 cfs, 20.0 acre feet per annum Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for construction and dust control purposes Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., MDB&M, Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. diversion the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1650.0 ft.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., MDB&M, Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1650.0 feet

7. Proposed place of use Sections 31-36, T.20N., R.19E., MDB&M, and Sections 1-18, T.19N., R.19E., MDB&M (see attachment #1).

8. Existing place of use Southwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 16, T.19N., R.19E., MDB&M (see attachments #2 & #3). (5.333 ac.)

9. Use will be from April 1 to November 30 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from as decreed to of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water to be diverted from the Highland Ditch to an existing holding pond, then pumping to trucks via portable fill station

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim No. 111, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on June 24, 1994 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

Permit 57318-T is expired with the issuance of this permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.028 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 20.0 acre-feet per season.....

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before.....

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before.....
