California 90209, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated in Nevada on June 22, 1970

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground - See Remarks

2. The amount of water applied for is up to 40 c.f.s. second-foot

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Commercial (nonconsumptive cooling)

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 7 bears South 73° 49' East, a distance of 1670 feet

6. Place of use within the SE 1/4, E 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 7; N 1/2 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 18; T.19N., R.20E., MDB&M, as shown on the supporting map

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) pump, pipeline and water distribution system from groundwater in existing Hilton Pond to Hotel for cooling and return to pond

9. Estimated cost of works..... in excess of \$500,000.....

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 2 years.....
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... 5 years.....

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

This application proposes to tap groundwater from the existing Hilton Pond. The water is to be used for nonconsumptive cooling at the existing hotel and related facilities within the place of use. Water will be pumped from the point of diversion to air conditioning units for cooling and returned to the pond.
