9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 45303, Certificate 13032 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 45303, Certificate 13032 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 45300, 45301, 45303 and 58657-T shall not exceed 31.5 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 22.4 million gallons annually.

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

A monthly report shall be submitted to the State Engineer within 10 days from the end of each month which shall include the amount of water pumped from the well and the amount of water used.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on May 27, 1994 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.
