

APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION TO CHANGE POINT OF DIVERSION, MANNER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE OF THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

The applicant MR Realty, a Nevada corporation, c/o Mirage Resorts, Inc. 3260 South Industrial Road of Las Vegas Nevada 89109

hereby make application for permission to change the point of diversion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 30700 Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is underground (Las Vegas Valley Artesian Basin)

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.3375 cfs, 100 acre feet annually

3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal (hotel and golf pro shop) and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for no change

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, T21S, R61E, MDB&M or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 20 bears North 28 degrees 59'18" West 1557.75 feet (Applicant's Well No. 2).

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, T21S, R61E, MDB&M or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 20 bears South 89 degrees 30'19" East a distance of 1983 feet. (Applicant's Well No. 5)

7. Proposed place of use NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, T21S, R61E, MDB&M (no change)

8. Existing place of use no change

9. Use will be from January 1 through December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 through December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) the works exist. Drilled well equipped with pump, motor and meter, and a system of conveyance piping, reservoirs and booster pumps to distribute water to its places of use in the hotel laundry and air conditioning cooling tower.

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

Quasi-Municipal (Hotel and Golf Pro Shop) water will and has been comingled with the water of Permits 30699, 30701 and 30702 to supply 22.51 acre feet per year to hotel laundry's 9 washing machines and 241.05 acre feet per year to hotel's 10,800 gpm cooling towers (3600 ton). APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30700 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30700 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 30702, Certificate 13746; 58761 and 58764 shall not exceed 263.56 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.3375 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 100.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 30, 1994

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 30, 1994

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 30, 1995

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 30, 1995

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A

Completion of work filed SEP 08 1994

Proof of beneficial use filed OCT 26 1994
