hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 30581, Certificate 9766

1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.012 CFS - 8.626 Acre Feet

3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, T16N, R19E.

MDM, or at a point from which the SW corner of the said Section 22 bears S.

74 deg. 10 min. W., a distance of 2,515.0 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, T16N, R19E.

MDM, or at a point from which the SW corner of the said Section 23 bears S.

2 deg. 05 min. W., a distance of 1,802.0 feet.

7. Proposed place of use within a portion of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4; a portion of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4; a

portion of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4; a portion of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, all in Section 22, T16N, R19E,

MDM, Washoe County Assessor's parcel number 055-200-50. Total - 10.749 acres.

8. Existing place of use within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23, T16N, R19E, MDM. Total -

2.40 acres.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and

specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled 12 1/2" diameter hole to a depth of 203

feet with 8 5/8" OD casing to bottom. Install submersible pump.

12. Estimated cost of works At least \$10,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works Well completed

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use.....Five (5) years.....

Water under this Application will be comingled with other water rights held by the applicant to cultivate lawn, garden and pasture appurtenant to APN 055-200-50. Use of overhead sprinklers and drip irrigation systems.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30581, Certificate 9766 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30581, Certificate 9766 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.012 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 8.626 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 15, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 15, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 15, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 15, 1999

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 15, 1999

Completion of work filed APR 07 1997

Proof of beneficial use filed NOV 23 1999

Cultural map filed NOV 23 1999

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The total combined duty of water under Permits 59019, 59020, 59021, 59023 and 59024 shall not exceed 20.0 acre-feet annually and is limited to the irrigation of 5.0 acres within the place of use.

All surface waters shall be used for irrigation prior to use of any of the supplemental groundwater.
