This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of Ash Canyon Creek AKA Gregory's Canyon Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 54849 which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion heretofore appropriated under Civil Decree of November 14, 1885, (Kings Canyon Creek et. al.) in the District Court of the State of Nevada in and for Carson City is hereby issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

Totalizing meters must be installed on the diversion works with annual reports submitted to the Division of Water Resources on the actual amount of water diverted under this permit. The works of diversion must not impede or restrict the flow of the channel in any manner. This permit is issued subject to the compliance with the rotation schedule established among the users of Ash Canyon Creek.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be ~~changed~~ <sup>appropriated</sup> shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 10.7620% ~~cubic feet per second~~ of the Waters of Ash Canyon Creek minus 52 acre-feet.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 18, 1999

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 18, 1999

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 18, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 18, 2003
