hereby make application for permission to change the
Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion
of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 24194 Certificate 7378

- 1. The source of water is Underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 479.96 Acre Feet 2.15 c.f.s.
3. The water to be used for Irrigation & Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation & Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 6 North, Range 66 East, M.D.M., at a point from which the Southwest Corner of said Sec. 35 bears S 02°00'48" W a distance of 1,310.98 feet. (Lincoln County)
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 26, T9N, R65E, M.D.M., or at a point from which the SE Corner of said Section 26 bears S 14° 45' E a distance of 4,250.0 feet. (Lincoln County)
7. Proposed place of use SW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 6 North, Range 66 East, M.D.M., - containing 160 acres of which 119.99 will be irrigated by pivot. 479.96 Acre feet of water will be utilized (Lincoln County)
8. Existing place of use 10.991 Ac. in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4; & 29.379 Ac. in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4; & 25.866 Ac. in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4; Sec. 26, and 2.486 Ac. in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4; & 40.618 Ac. in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4; & 10.65 Ac. in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 25; all within T9N, R65E, M.D.M., (Lincoln County) 119.99 Total
9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well will be drilled and cased to a depth sufficient to service a rotary pivot system. Lines will be installed to supply pivot.
12. Estimated cost of works \$40,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24194, Certificate 7378 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24194, Certificate 7378 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.15 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 479.96 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 21, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 21, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 21, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 21, 1999

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
