hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

A non profit corporation, February 19, 1987, Amargosa Valley, Nv.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is An underground source in Amargosa Valley, NV.

2. The amount of water applied for is .07 second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Commercial purposes

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") Commercial

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point Gov't Lot 2 Within the SE 1/4 of Section 35, T.16S., R.49E., M.D.M., at a point from which the survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. East 1/4 corner of said section 35 bears N 58° 18' 44" E. a distance of 2203 feet.

6. Place of use Parcel 4 as shown on parcel map File 263165, Nye County Records, within Government lot 2, of the SE. 1/4 of section 35, T.16 S., R. 49 E., M.D.M..

7. Use will begin about January 1st. and end about December 31 st., of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) 8" diameter drilled well, cased all the way, with a 2 hp. submersible pump with 2" pipe and pressure tank.

9. Estimated cost of works..... \$6000.

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 1 year
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... 3 years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

The water is needed for sanitation, 6 sinks, 3 toilets, and drinking water, plus some water is needed for future landscaping. 5 acre feet of water is needed annually.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.007 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet annually.
