Point of Diversion and temporary Use of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under App. 53322

This application requests permission for temporary use of a portion of the

duty allowed under 53322. A full application to change will be filed.

1. The source of water is Underground, Garnet Valley

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.5 cfs

3. The water to be used for Industrial and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for Industrial and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, T.18S., R.64E., MDM, or at a point whence the N 1/4 Corner of said Section 19 bears N. 57° 23' W. a distance of 207.5 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, T.18S., R.64E., MDM, or at a point whence the NE Corner of said Section 18 bears N. 40 49' 36" E. a distance of 3008.5 feet.

7. Proposed place of use Portions of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, AND SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T.18S., R.64E., MDM, and portions of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 19, T.18S., R.64E., MDM, also being Resurvey Tract 37 and known as Kelly Placer Mining Claim

8. Existing place of use Same as Proposed Place of Use

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled and cased well, pump, motor, meter, pipelines and valves to the places of use.

12. Estimated cost of works 50,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works 1 month - Exploratory well completed

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... 2 years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

This Application serves as Application for a Temporary Use Permit until application to change is granted. The water will be for use in an industrial waste center and will be for landfill dust control, cooling, incinerator scrubber, fire protection, landscaping, sanitary and drinking. The estimated annual use from this well is 45 MG

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 53322 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 53322 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 53322 and 59216-T shall not exceed 274 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on October 7, 1994 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 137

acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....
