Four allotment holders can run a total of 4555 sheep and 407 cows. The number of wildlife using the area is unknown, but the historic recorded flow to be replaced is 30 gpm

OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56407 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56407 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well for stockwatering purposes and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.067 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 4555 sheep and 407 cows, but not to exceed 48.39 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....
