WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA**

The applicant **United States of America, U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management**, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is **Salt Spring**
2. The amount of water applied for is **0.0019 (0.86 GAL./MIN.)** second-feet
 - (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet
3. The water to be used for **WILDLIFE**
4. If use is for:
 - (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
 - (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered
 - (c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") **50 Bighorn sheep and unknown numbers of other wildlife.**
 - (d) Power:
 - (1) Horsepower developed
 - (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point **in the SW Quarter (1/4) of the NE Quarter (1/4) of the NE Quarter (1/4) of Section 19, T.17S., R.70E., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 19, 17S, R.70E., M.D.&M. Bears S.75° 57' E. a distance of 4,136 FT.**
6. Place of Use **SW ¼ NE ¼ NE ¼ Sec. 19 T.17S., R.70E. Land is unsurveyed, GPS equipment was used to locate position.**
7. Use will begin about **January 1** and end about **December 31** of each year.
8. Description of proposed works **water will not be diverted fence will be constructed to protect riparian area.**
9. Estimated cost of works **\$5000**
10. Estimated time required to construct works **1 yr.**
11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use **2 yrs.**

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12. Remarks: 50 Bighorn sheep and unknown number of other wildlife.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0003 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 50 Bighorn sheep.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before:

January 14, 2001

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before:

February 14, 2001

Water must be placed to beneficial use on or before:

January 14, 2002

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

February 14, 2002

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:
