Wyoming 82001, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.60 cfs second-foot

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Industrial & Domestic

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25, T33N, R52E, MDB&M., at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 25, bears N 76°04'47" W, 2160.00 feet.

6. Place of use Portions of NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, T33N, R52E, MDB&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well with Pipelines

flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

- 9. Estimated cost of works.....\$50,000
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works.....three years

Waters to be used for 2 restrooms, wash basins & showers, dust control, cleanup of vehicles and fire suppression. Annual consumptive use to be 15 gal/min, 24 hours/day, 365 days/year equaling 7,884,000 gals/year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed.....0.60.....cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 7.88 million gallons annually.
