a total of 37.758 acres and 151.03 acre-feet annually.

Surface water is to be diverted from drains and the Boynton Slough through use of temporary diversion structures and used for runway base compaction and dust mitigation in the proposed place of use. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This temporary permit to change the place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim No. 474 and 475, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 59856-T and 59857-T shall not exceed 210.32 acre-feet annually.

Water measuring devices and totalizing meters must be installed and accurate records must be kept of the water diverted and placed to beneficial use.

A monthly report of the water diverted and placed to beneficial use must be submitted to the State Engineer and Federal Water Master on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on May 23, 1995 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is issued subject to the regulation of the irrigation season as established by the Federal Water Master.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.9446 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 151.03 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....
