Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use
 of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 25590, Certificate 7787

1. The source of water is an underground source (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)
Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.05 cfs, not to exceed 11.8 mga or 11.8 mga in combination with Permit 25225
Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.
3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal (Resort Hotel)
Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.
4. The water heretofore permitted for Recreation (golf course irrigation) and domestic
Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 16, T21S, R61E, M.D.M., or a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 16 bears S 84° 21' E, a distance of 2,593 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 16, T21S, R61E, M.D.B.&M., or a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 16 bears S 63° 05' E, a distance of 2,305 feet.

Proposed place of use 56.6± acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 16; the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, T21S, R61E, M.D.B.&M., bounded on the West by Las Vegas Blvd., on the South by Sands Avenue, on the North by Desert Inn Road, and on the East by the Desert Inn Golf Course. Desert Inn and Desert Kingdom resort hotel sites.
Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.
8. Existing place of use 5.3 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 16, T21S, R61E, M.D.B.&M.

Refer to the map on File in Permit No. 24558 showing the existing POD and POU. Use for outdoor water features, swimming pools and landscape irrigation for Desert Inn and Desert Kingdom. Estimated use on 56.6 acre place of use, 8.93 acres landscape at 3.5 ac-ft/acre, 1.34 acres swimming pools at 7.0 ac-ft/acre, and 3.5 acres of water features at 9.5 ac-ft/acre. Supply to be supplemented by other wells (i.e. Permit 13393), gray water from hotel rooms (if feasible), reclaimed water from cooling towers (if feasible), and Las Vegas Valley Water District water.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 25590, Certificate 7787 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 25590, Certificate 7787 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60164 and 60165 shall not exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 28, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 28, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 28, 1998

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 28, 1998

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
