1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 3 cfs Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Gravel Plant Operation Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 22, T 17 N, R 63 E, MDM, Whence the W 1/4 corner of said Section 22 bears S 81 30' 00" W, 3921.64 feet distant. OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 51757 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 51757 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 32980, 32981, 32985, 60211 and 60269 shall not exceed 900.0 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 300.0 acres within the described place of use.

This permit is issued subject to the Stipulation filed in the Seventh Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the County of White Pine and filed in the Office of the State Engineer, Case No. 11932, dated 28th day of May, 1983.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 92.066 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.
