- 1. The source of water is the Truckee River
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.6301 c.f.s. - 107 acre feet annually
3. The water to be used for Municipal and Domestic
4. The water heretofore permitted for as Decreed
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point the Points of Diversion of Sierra's existing water treatment plants are described in the attached Exhibit "A" and shown on the map supporting Applications 49886 and 49887 on file at the Division of Water Resources, State of Nevada.
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the Southeast One Quarter of the Southeast One Quarter of Section 7, Township 19 North, Range 20 East, Mount Diablo Meridian.
7. Proposed place of use the certificated water service area of Sierra Pacific Power Co. as described in the legal description and shown on the supporting map on file in the Office of the Nevada State Engineer, and the legally described real property in the attached Exhibit "B".
8. Existing place of use 8.2 acres in the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and 18.6 acres in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, all in Section 17, Township 19 North, Range 20 East, Mount Diablo Meridian.
9. Use will be from as Decreed to of each year.
10. Use was permitted from as Decreed to of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water will be diverted at existing Sierra Pacific facilities, treated, and placed into existing distribution system.
12. Estimated cost of works in excess of \$50,000,000.00 has been invested.
13. Estimated time required to construct works Completed

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... One Year

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

During 1993, Sierra Pacific served an average of 57,702 non-duplicate customers and delivered approximately 19,023.16 million gallons annually (58,380 acre feet). Maximum daily delivery is approximately 100.07 million gallons (306.9 acre feet).

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 596, Truckee River Final Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.6301..... cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 107.0 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... June 26, 1996

Exhibit "A"

The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Sierra Pacific Power Company Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the maps accompanying Application Nos. 49886 and 49887 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.


LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Situated in Section 1, Township 20 North, Range 20 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Washoe County, Nevada, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the South East Section Corner of Section 1, Township 20 North, Range 20 East, M.D.M., as shown on Record of Survey No. 910, Document No. 381618, filed in the office of the Washoe County Recorder. Thence South 89°48'36" West along the South Section Line of said Section 1 a distance of 1202.59 feet to the East 1/16 Corner of Sections 1 and 12 as shown on said Record of Survey. Thence North 01°05'27" West along the West line of the East half of the South East 1/4 of said Section 1 a distance of 1327.15 feet. Thence South 89°50'42" West along the South line of the North West Quarter of the South East Quarter of said Section 1 a distance of 1,101.62 feet. Thence North 02°05'03" West 1314.95 feet to a point. Thence the following Bearings and Distances:

- South 89° 36' 37" West a distance of 155.57 feet;
- North 02° 05' 02" West a distance of 1.41 feet;
- South 89° 37' 24" West a distance of 2343.89 feet;
- North 00° 16' 16" East a distance of 2,666.26 feet;
- North 89° 55' 00" East a distance of 2,198.79 feet;
- North 89° 46' 00" East a distance of 2,652.65 feet;
- South 00° 10' 30" East a distance of 2,648.22 feet;
- South 00° 06' 00" East a distance of 2,651.00 feet to the point of beginning.
