waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.25 cfs second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Commercial & Domestic purposes

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks") Commercial & Domestic Purposes

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within SW1/4NW1/4 of Section 6, T.35N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W1/4 corner of said Section 6 bears S 52° 09'00" W a distance of 1026.0 feet.

6. Place of use 6.33 acres, more or less, within the SW1/4NW1/4 of Section 6, T.35N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drill well, install pump, motor, pipe-line, & pressure tank.

- 9. Estimated cost of works in excess of \$6,000.00
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years  
If well completed, describe works.
- 11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

Applicant wishes to provide water to up to 5 commercial buildings, landscaping purposes, & dust control purposes. Estimated annual consumptive use will be approximately 5 million gallons annually.


DENIAL
