APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance for pollution control as mandated by orders issued by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection and subsequent correspondence with said agency. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and records of this measurement shall be submitted on an annual basis. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level of permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water granted herein at any and all times. * The right will cease to exist upon termination of clean up activity as determined by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.307 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 5.067 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....*

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.4075. Well driller's reports for any well(s) drilled under this permit shall be filed within 30 days from completion of the well.

Within 30 days after the completion of the project, the permittee shall notify the State Engineer of such completion and all wells shall be plugged and abandoned in accordance with Chapter 534 of the Nevada Administrative Code.
