hereby makes application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 54466

1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.12000 cfs 12.00 acre feet annually

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 16 Township 22 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian at a point from which the southwest corner of said Section 16 bears South 10°56'12" West, 4079.29 feet. (Well No. 5) See Permit 28071

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 16 Township 22 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, at a point from which the southeast corner of said Section 16 bears South 43°46'06" East, 1860.90 feet.

7. Proposed place of use NE SE, Section 9; NE NE, SE NE, Section 16; all in T.22N., R.21E., M.D.M.

8. Existing place of use NW NW Sec 10; NE SE, SE SE Sec 9; NE NE, SE NE, NE SE, SE SE Sec 16; SW NW, NW SW, SW SW, SE SW, NE SW Sec 15; all in T.22N. R.21E., M.D.M. See map supporting PERMIT 54460.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54466 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54466 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60498-T, 60499-T, 60500-T, 60501-T, 60502-T, 60503-T, 60504-T, 60505-T, 60506-T, 60507-T, 60508-T, 60509-T, inclusive, shall not exceed 299.90 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 75.0 acres within the described place of use.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to

exceed 0.120 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 12.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.
