1. The source of water is Sharp Spring Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.025 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Stockwatering Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Stockwatering Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 16, T. 1 S., R. 58 E., MDB&M Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and

distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place of use of waters of Sharp Spring as heretofore granted under Permit 4865, Certificate 944, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 4865, Certificate 944, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The state retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on February 7, 1996 at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....
