Point of Diversion and Place of Use of A Portion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 58885 Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0420 CFS (24.70 AFA) Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-Municipal and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NE1/4 of Section 12, T.12N.,

R.20E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section

12 bears North 61°59'15" West, 2,271.40 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW1/4 Section 35, T.13N.,

R.20E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S1/4 corner of said Section 35 bears

South 46°14'44" East, 1,940.49 feet.

7. Proposed place of use is within a portion of the NW1/4 of Section 12, T.12N., R.20E.,

M.D.M.

8. Existing place of use within portions of NE1/4SE1/4 Section 34, and portions of the

SW1/4 Section 35, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.M., as shown on the supporting map for

manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

Permits 49432 and 49433.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 58885 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 58885 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60602 and 60603 shall not exceed 24.70 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0414 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 24.70 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 30, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 30, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 30, 1997

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 30, 1997

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A

Completion of work filed AUG 06 1997

Proof of beneficial use filed SEP 22 2003
