This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This secondary permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions under Permit 60664. The granting of this secondary permit is not intended in any way to waive or affect authority or requirements of water quality control agencies or regulations. This permit is further issued subject to the provisions of NRS 533.440 and the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. This secondary permit is issued subject to existing rights.

This secondary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of effluent under Permits 60664S03 and 60664S04 shall not exceed 560.07acre feet annually.

The total combined duty of effluent under Permits 60664S03, 60664S04 and 71805S02 shall not exceed 1680.22 acre feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.862 cubic feet per second or 482.92 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: **September 21, 2010**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: **September 21, 2012**

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before: **September 21, 2012**
