The applicant Las Vegas Valley Water District, a quasi-municipal corporation

Nevada 89153 hereby makes application for permission to change the

point of diversion of a portion of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 55883
Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is underground - Las Vegas Valley Ground-Water Basin

2. The amount of water to be changed .014 cfs or 10 acre-feet per year

3. The water to be used for municipal and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for municipal and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 Section 34, T. 20S., R. 60E., M. D. B. & M.
or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 34 bears S. 19°50'43"W.
a distance of 297.12 feet. (Map filed November 29, 1972, under Permit No. 27158)

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 20S., R. 60E., M. D. B. & M.
or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 23 bears N. 79°24'05"W.
a distance of 703.89 feet. (Map filed September 26, 1989, under Permit No. 53919)

7. Proposed place of use is the area described within the Las Vegas Valley Water District
as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as it now exists or as it
may hereafter be amended. (map filed under Permit 53732)

8. Existing place of use is the area described within the Las Vegas Valley Water District
as denoted by Chapter 167, Statutes of Nevada, 1947, as it now exists or as it
may hereafter be amended. (map filed under Permit 53732)

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) water is to be diverted from a 16-inch diameter cased well approximately 1,003 feet deep, known as District Well No. 23, pipe to deep well pump, pipelines, reservoirs, and distribution system.

12. Estimated cost of works \$120,000.00

13. Estimated time required to construct works 16-inch diameter well drilled to 1,003 ft. casing construction consisted of a 20-inch diameter conductor pipe to a depth of 102 ft.

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use five years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use:

This application to change the point of diversion of a portion of waters heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 55883 moves 10 acre-feet per annum from District Well No. 73 to District Well No. 21 due to supply redistribution.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 55883 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 55883 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.014 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 10.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 14, 1995

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 14, 1995

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 14, 1997

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 14, 1997

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
