hereby make application for permission to change the place of use and manner of use of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit #31393, Certificate #9099

1. The source of water is Underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0689 CFS not to exceed 30.07 acre feet annually

3. The water to be used for quasi municipal and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, T. 21N., R. 20E., M. D. B. & M.

Plot 69 to and including Plot 80 as shown on Map to designate areas for transfer and relinquishment of water heretofore appropriated under Permit numbers 29646, 32882 and 31393 (Certificate Numbers 9098, 9099 and 9825) from an underground source as filed with the State Engineer on April 7, 1983 - 1.20 acres

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) existing drilled and cased well equipped with pump and motor. Water will be delivered to existing and future water customers through existing and future distribution systems and appurtenances

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 31393, Certificate 9099 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 31393, Certificate 9099 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60779 and 60780 shall not exceed 30.07 acre-feet annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0689 cubic feet per second ~~but not to exceed 30.07 acre-feet annually.~~

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 8, 1997

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 8, 1997

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 8, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 8, 1999

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
