

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Valley Electric Association, Inc.

89041, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground - Pahrump Valley

2. The amount of water applied for is 1,800 gal./day (657,000 gal/yr) 0.021 c.f.s. second-feet

3. The water to be used for commercial office use

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated.

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered.

(2) Point of return of water to stream.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15,

T. 20S, R. 53E MDB&M, at a point that bears North 76°16' West a distance of

1,065 feet from the SE corner of said Section 15.

6. Place of use. Within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 15, T20S, R53E MDB&M

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) well, casing, pump, pressure tank and

distribution pipe line.

**APPROVAL** OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.021 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 2.02 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 30, 1996

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 30, 1996

Application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 30, 1998

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 30, 1998


