

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

April 17, 1992, Carson City, Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Deer Creek

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.09 C.F.S. second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal & Domestic

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered

(c) Other use (describe fully under No. 12. "Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec 7, T19S, R57E M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the S.E. Corner of said Sec 7 Bears S 79° 20' 00" E 3,129 feet.

6. Place of use S 1/2 SW 1/4 Sec 7 T19S R57E M.D.B. & M., W 1/2 Sec 12, T19S R56E MDM.

7. Use will begin about Jan 1 and end about Dec 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) A collection basin & diversion pipeline to a tank and thence via pipeline or truckline distribution.

9. Estimated cost of works \$5,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works Three (3) Years
